

COLLEGE OF EDUCATION TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION/PEDAGOGY OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The Department of Physical Education and Recreation, College of Education at the Río Piedras Campus announces a search to fill a full time tenure track position in the area of Curriculum and instruction/pedagogy of Physical Education or Kinesiology with physical education teacher preparation or sport pedagogy, to begin in August 2016.

Requirements: terminal degree (Ph.D. or Ed.D.) in Curriculum and instruction/pedagogy of Physical Education or Kinesiology with physical education teacher preparation or sport pedagogy from an accredited and recognized institution; teaching experience at the undergraduate and graduate levels; evidence of research, grant writing, peer-review publications in the discipline; evidence of community work and professional services; evidence of his/her active membership in professional organization in their discipline; knowledge of the new technologies; evidence of presentations, conferences, seminars, workshops at national and international levels; proficiency in Spanish and English; experience with accreditations process of professional organizations; experience in multidisciplinary research projects in different learning communities; evidence of the ability to research grant writing and external funding.

Responsibilities: Active research project. Teach courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Publish research articles in professional peer-reviewed journals, and present conference in their expertise in academic forums. Active participation in community services. Collaboration with the Department of Graduate Studies and mentor thesis/dissertation projects. Teach courses programmed during the day, evening and Saturday. Develop proposal seeking external funding. Participate in Departmental committees among other academic tasks. Accomplishment of the responsibilities covered by the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.

The evaluation of applications will begin on April 2016 and will continue until the position is filled. Candidates must send the following documents: 1) Cover letter stating how candidate can contribute to the mission of the Department; 2) Curriculum vitae, 3) Official transcripts of all degrees; 4)Copies of diplomas of all educational degrees; 5) Two recent letters of recommendations (6 months); 6)Evidences of publications and academic presentations to:
