The School of Architecture, at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico announces a search to fill a full time, tenure track faculty position in the area of Design, History and Theory of Architecture to begin in **August 2016**.

Requirements: Applicants must be Architect with a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in a related discipline from an accredited university. The successful candidate must have teaching experience at both the undergraduate and graduate levels; proven capacity to advise thesis projects at the graduate level; capacity for research/documented creative work; committed to excellence in teaching and to generate external funds; proficiency in Spanish and English.

<u>Responsibilities</u>: Teach undergraduate and graduate courses and seminars on different schedules, including evening and Saturday; actively conduct research and publish in their areas of specialty; supervise thesis, dissertations and professional practices; develop proposals seeking external funding; participate actively in departmental activities and projects, as well as those at the School of Architecture and the Río Piedras Campus and to fulfill all other obligations of a teaching job.
