

## COLLEGE OF GENEAL STUDIES TENURE TRACK POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT Hispanic American, Peninsular Literatures or Teaching Spanish to Native Speakers

The Spanish Department, College of General Studies at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico, seeks to fill a full-time, tenuretrack position at the level of Assistant Professor in the areas of Hispanic

American, Peninsular Literatures or Teaching Spanish to Native Speakers to begin in August 2016.

**Requirements:** Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Hispanic Literatures or Language Education in Spanish from an accredited university; professional and research experience in one or more of the following areas of expertise: Hispanic American, Peninsular or Teaching Spanish to native speakers. The successful candidate must also have a solid academic preparation and be committed to excellence in teaching of both first-year Spanish courses (Remedial, Basic and Honors) and second-year literature courses that fulfill the General Education Component; along with the ability to develop proposals for external funds and to create new courses. The candidate must have knowledge in the use of educational technologies, proficiency in Spanish and English, and be willing to serve on college and university committees.

**<u>Responsibilities</u>**: To teach all levels of first-year courses and second-year literature courses during day, night and Saturday classes; to conduct research and to publish in their areas of expertise; to develop proposals for external funding; to participate in departmental and university activities and projects, as well as to fulfill all other obligations of a teaching position. The responsibilities of the prospective candidate are covered by the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.
