Requirements: Doctor's degree (PhD) in Geography from an accredited university. Teaching experience at the university level. Applicants should be able to demonstrate skills with computer programs such as: Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and Remote Sensing. Furthermore, applicants should have publications published in arbitrated professional journals or magazines. Demonstrate excellent ability to work in a multidisciplinary and collaborative environment. All of research areas in physical geography shall be considered. Proficient in Spanish and English.

Responsibilities: Develop research programs recognized and subsidized with external and Institutional funding. Professional publications in their area of expertise. Most importantly, they must be committed to the excellence of undergraduate education as well as integrating themselves and contributing with the department, school and campus initiatives.
