

TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT GRADUATE PROGRAM IN TRANSLATION

The Graduate Program in Translation, University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus, offers an MA in Translation and a Post-MA Certificate of Specialization. The Program announces a search to fill a full-time, tenure-track faculty position in the area of English-to-Spanish Translation, to begin in January 2017.

<u>Requirements:</u> Applicants must have at the time of hiring a Ph.D. in Translation or Translation Studies from an accredited university; proven practical experience in translation in one or more areas of specialization; teaching and research experience at the university level in their area of specialization; commitment to excellence in teaching; and be versant in the use of translation-related technologies and audiovisual translation. Applicants must be native speakers of Spanish with oral and written mastery of the English language. Knowledge of a third language is desirable.

<u>Responsibilities</u>: Teach graduate courses and seminars following a day, evening and Saturday schedule; research and publish in the areas of specialization; supervise graduate research projects and theses; participate actively in departmental activities (committees and other responsibilities), as well as those at the College of Humanities and the Río Piedras Campus, and fulfill all other obligations of a teaching position. Full-Time Equivalency is 12 credits per semester. The responsibilities of the prospective candidate are covered under the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.

Evaluation will commence immediately, and applications will be received until October 31, 2016. Applicants must send: 1) cover letter describing their academic philosophy and vision, as well as relevant research and publications; 2) curriculum vitae; 3) copy of the academic credentials of all their degrees; 4) evidence of their research, professional and creative work and achievements; 5) student evaluations; 6) three recommendation letters, to:
