



Bid announcement for the recruitment of a Librarian to a tenure track position, effective August 1, 2019,
at the University of Puerto Rico, Rio Piedras Campus Library System.

The Library System of the University of Puerto Rico Rio Piedras Campus will consider applicants for the position of librarian to offer information services to underserved groups, with emphasis on disabled persons (Deaf and Hard of Hearing).

Requirements

- Master's Degree in Library Science (MLS) or Information Science (MSI) from an American Library Association (ALA) accredited institution.
- Experience offering services to special needs users and/or continuing education to Deaf/hearing impaired and Hard of Hearing.
- Knowledge and experience with use of assistive technologies/tools.
- Fluency in spoken and written Spanish and English; desirable but knowledge of sign language.
- Ability to offer virtual services. Proficiency in the use of information search and retrieval systems.
- Ability for research or creative work.
- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively.
- Availability to work night, weekend, and holiday shifts, face-to-face and online.
- Willingness to develop external funds.
- Publications.

Responsibilities

1. Coordinate the services offered to underserved populations, with special attention to disabled users.
2. Ensure compliance with the laws relating to services provided to disabled persons such as: Lema de Derechos de las Personas con Discapacidades (Law 716), Sistema de Servicios Bibliotecarios para Personas con Discapacidades (Law 61), both law enacted in the Puerto Rican legislature, and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
3. Serve as liaison to the community providers to coordinate transcription services, use of assistive technologies, offering events, and any other tools to facilitate information services for this population.
4. Evaluate and recommend the acquisition of programs and equipment to facilitate information services to persons with functional diversity or use of alternative means to access information.
5. Encourage projects, research, public, health, grant proposals, and any other component for improvement of services for the aforementioned population in the Puerto Rican Library System.
6. Develop activities to raise awareness of and sensitivity for the populations with special information needs.

5. Letter of recommendation.

The person whose applications comply with all requirements will be called for interview.
