CALL FOR A TENURE TRACK TEACHING POSITION**

The Graduate School of Information Science and Technologies of the University of Puerto Rico, Rio Piedras Campus, invites you to apply for a tenure track teaching position, beginning in August 2011, in the area specified below.

Main teaching area: Organization and retrieval of information, with an emphasis on the analysis, evaluation, and design of libraries and digital archives. Will work with information systems, programming, and administration of electronic platforms for content and document management, and information architecture.

Requirements: Doctoral degree (PhD, D.L.S.) in Information Science, Computing, or other discipline closely related to the area of research in library or information science, computing, data management, or data science granted by a prestigious educational institution. Should have professional experience in programming or designing information systems, archives, or digital libraries. Proven capacity on effective face-to-face and distance learning modalities, availability to lead research projects, previous professional experience in proposal preparation and other commitment to research for external funding.

Additional requirements: Experience in university level teaching, preferably at the graduate level, and in the application of information and communication technologies in the teaching-learning process. Demonstrate experience in research and have authored publications in the discipline. Experience in private consulting is welcome. Fluency of Spanish and English languages is required.

Responsibilities: Teach in masters and certificate programs, mainly in distance modality, advise students in their research, research and publish in your area of expertise, develop proposals to seek external funds, assume leadership in the update and development of the certificate and emphasis area on document and file management, active participation in the School's work committees and university management.

Deadline and Procedures: April 12, 2011 is the deadline to submit the required documents. Qualified interested parties must submit in electronic format: expression of interest letter, updated curriculum vitae, official academic credentials or diploma, copy of (or link to) your publications and three recommendation letters. Qualified candidates will be invited to make a presentation to the School community.
