The Graduate School of Information Science and Technologies of the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus, invites you to apply for a tenure track teaching position, beginning on August 1st, 2021, in the area specified below.

Main teaching area: Organization and retrieval of information, with an emphasis on the analysis, evaluation, and design of libraries and digital archives. Will work with information systems, programming, and administration of electronic platforms for content and document management, and information architecture


Requirements: Doctoral degree (PhD, DLS) in Information Science, Computing, or other discipline closely related to the area of research in library or information science, computing, data management, or data science granted by a prestigious educational institution. Should have professional experience in programming or designing information systems, archives, or digital libraries. Proven capacity on effective face-to-face and distance learning modalities, availability to lead research projects, previous professional experiences in proposal preparation and show commitment to search for external funding.

Additional Requirements: Experience in university-level teaching, preferably at the graduate level, and in the application of information and communication technologies in the teaching-learning process. Demonstrate experience in research and have arbitrated publications in the discipline. Experience in private consulting is welcome. Mastery of Spanish and English languages is required.

Responsibilities: Teach in the masters and certificates programs, mainly in distance modality; advise students in their research; research and publish in your area of expertise; develop proposals to seek external funds; assume leadership in the update and development of the certificate and emphasis area on document and file management; active participation in the School's work committees and university management.

Deadline and Procedures: April 12, 2021 is the deadline to submit the required documents. Qualified interested parties must submit in electronic format: expression of interest letter, updated curriculum vitae; official academic credentials of all grades, copy of (or link to) your publications and three recommendation letters. Qualified candidates will be invited to make a presentation to the School community.
