

- Doctoral degree or PhD in rehabilitation counseling or in a related field from an accredited university.
 If the candidate doesn't have a doctoral degree in rehabilitation counseling, must have a master's degree in rehabilitation counseling from an accredited university.
- Must have the Rehabilitation Counselor Certification (CRC)
- Possess professional and academic experience in the rehabilitation counseling field
- Capacity for effective face-to-face and distance education at the post-secondary level
- Capacity for research and creative work
- Publications in the rehabilitation counseling field or related fields
- Community service experience
- Experience in elaboration of proposals and commitment to seeking external funds
- Competencies in one or more of the following specialty areas:
 - Psychiatric rehabilitation
 - Crisis intervention
 - Trauma management
 - Group and family counseling
 - Interventions with persons with a history of substance abuse
 - Consultation
 - Advocacy
 - Leadership



It is required that the candidate:

- Offer a variety of courses in Spanish, as well as supervise research, among others
- Teach face to face and distance education at postgraduate level
- Conduct research and publish in the rehabilitation counseling or related fields.
