**CALL FOR TENURE TRACK TEACHING POSITION**

**Minimum Requirements:**

1. Professional degree in architecture, master's, or doctoral degree granted by a recognized and accredited institution.
2. Teaching experience offering architectural design courses, focusing on emergent features of the architectural profession, at both undergraduate and/or graduate levels and in recognized and accredited institutions.
3. Professional experience in architecture (design, construction documents development and/or construction management) for a minimum of five years.
4. Professional license in architecture is preferred.
5. Capability to direct master's thesis and investigations.
6. Capability for in-person and online teaching.
7. Experience in research, creative, and architectural work.
8. Commitment to pursue external/fund of Campus funding.
9. Publications in candidate's area of expertise.

**Responsibilities:**

The tasks that correspond to this teaching position include teaching architectural design courses and offer in-person and/or online specialized courses, availability to offer weekend and evening courses, at undergraduate and graduate levels, with a demonstrated particular interest in emergent architectural production, research, and publications in their area of expertise, participation in academic committees, and administrative support as part of the contractual obligation. The position is scheduled to begin on 1<sup>st</sup> of August of 2023.

**Required Documents:**

1. Letter of interest.
2. Updated Curriculum Vitae (two page maximum length).
3. Official professional and academic credentials of all degrees. Evidence of Master Thesis completion and courses offered at University level (please indicate if the course were offered in in person, hybrid and/or online).
4. Evidence of recent presentations at conferences, publications, and research work.
5. Portfolio of professional and creative work.
6. Teaching and Research Philosophy statements (maximum one page length each).
7. Statement of intention to pursue external funding opportunities.
8. Two recommendation letters.
