

**RECRUITMENT ANNOUNCEMENT FOR A TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITION
AT THE DEPARTMENT OF BIOLOGY
OF THE COLLEGE OF NATURAL SCIENCES**

The Department of Biology of the College of Natural Sciences, University of Puerto Rico, Rio Piedras Campus announces the search for candidates for a tenure-track faculty position in the field of Microbiology with experience in omics data analysis to begin on August 1, 2021.

Requirements: The candidates should have a PhD or an equivalent degree in Biology (Microbiology with experience in omics) or in a related discipline from an accredited university; postdoctoral experience; publications in area of specialty; experience and commitment in preparing proposals to seek external funds; teaching experience at the university level; commitment to excellence in teaching and availability to direct thesis ; knowledge of educational technologies and capacity for both in-person and distance effective teaching. Proficiency in both Spanish and English is an advantage.

Responsibilities: In-person and distance teaching at undergraduate and graduate level at all available teaching hours. Carry out research and professional publications in the field of expertise in peer-reviewed journals. Supervise BScs, dissertations, and professional practices. Develop proposals to seek and obtain external funds. Actively participate in the Departmental and University life and fulfill all the responsibilities of teaching faculty included in the General Regulations of UPR.

The evaluations will begin on April 26, 2021. Applicants should send: 1) an intention letter describing academic vision, research areas, publications and teaching; 2) Updated Curriculum vitae; 3) copy of all academic files; 4) evidence of research, publications, and creative work; 5) three reference letters.
