

General Basic Academic Position

The University/College has a broad range of academic positions for students with varying academic skills as reported on the following chart:

Requirements:

- 1. Each student is to complete a minimum of the following degrees: Post-101 (21) or an equivalent recognized institution.
- 2. All degrees to receive academic recognition to receive one of the following:
 - a. Faculty Law, Law and Social Sciences, Business, Property, Medicine, Criminal Law, Criminal Investigation, Heavy Law, or Strategic Law.
- 3. The candidate must be admitted to the position of Law in accordance with Florida Bar regulations or another jurisdiction and must have oral and written assessment of the Spanish and English languages as well as experience in effective law writing in print and online.
- 4. The candidate must have academic publications in the field of Law.
- 5. Ability to conduct academic work.
- 6. Available to the profession and
- 7. Government or writing-related testing.
