The Physics Department of the College of Natural Sciences, University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus, announces the search for candidates for a tenure track teaching appointment in the area of Theoretical Physics, effective August 1, 2021.

**Requirements:** Candidates must possess a PhD degree in Physics from an accredited university, teaching experience at the higher education level, a good track record in research and publishing, a good command of English, and the ability to mentor graduate and undergraduate students. Must have demonstrable capacity in effective teaching in face-to-face and distance modality. Availability to direct research projects. Experience in preparing proposals and demonstrate commitment to seeking external funds. Show experience in research and have peer-reviewed publications.

**Responsibilities:** The chosen candidate must be able to teach face-to-face and distance courses both at the undergraduate and graduate levels; participate in the development of externally funded projects, create a competitive research program, and engage in collaborations with other groups. Supervise theses, dissertations and professional practices.

The Physics Department has a diverse faculty involved in various research areas in both Theoretical and Experimental Physics, which maintains collaborations with personnel from other departments and other institutions.
