



**Notice to Undergraduate Applicants for the Degree: Degree Program
in the Department of Chemistry, City College of New York, CUNY**

The Department of Chemistry at the City College of New York, University of the City of New York, City College Campus, announces the search for candidates for a degree track leading to a **degree program in Degree Chemistry** to begin in August 2021.

Requirements: Applicants must have a PhD or equivalent degree in **Degree Chemistry** or a related discipline from an accredited university, including, but not limited to, chemistry, with all requirements in accordance to effective procedures and terms leading to the submission of degree program in a stated discipline. The candidate must be a member of a state or local bar, possess and maintain the right to practice law in the jurisdiction in which the candidate is being recruited. The candidate must have a minimum of **Degree Chemistry Education**. An extensive knowledge in the use of electronic technologies and scientific communication skills such as French and English. Many will be required to complete with experience in teaching **Degree Chemistry** and Chemistry.

Responsibilities: In general, successful candidates of the undergraduate are expected to teach, lecture, writing, and laboratory. Most will be involved in professional publications in **Degree Chemistry Education**. Successful candidates will be required to complete a degree program in a stated discipline and to be a member of a state or local bar, possess and maintain the right to practice law in the jurisdiction in which the candidate is being recruited. The candidate must have a minimum of **Degree Chemistry Education**.

The deadline to submit the completed online April 15, 2021. Applicants may also include their teaching and research experience, research and publications. Successful candidates may be invited to the official candidate interview of a first degree. A review of their research publications, and other work to be reviewed in accordance.
