

The following information is given to enable public stakeholders and to other stakeholders with the United States Department of Education requirements related to the Coronavirus Act, 2020 and Economic Security Act, 2020, for use in the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2020.

The University of Western Australia has received, under the relevant grant, the direct funding support for the implementation of COVID-19 relief measures. The funding will be used to support the University of Western Australia's strategic priorities.
