Requirements

- Ph.D. Degree in Planning or doctoral degree in related areas from an accredited institution
- Specialization: Environment and Society or Social-Environmental Planning
- Capacity in at least three of the following areas: Environment and Society; Social-Environmental Planning; Climate Change; Public Policy and Regulations for Environmental and Natural Resources; Sustainability and Sustainable Communities; Social-environmental Justice; Political Ecology; Local and Regional Environmental Analytical Methods; Environmental Governance; Spatial Analysis applied to Environmental Planning
- Capacity to offer courses related to Planning History, Theory and Practice; Implementation; Research Methods; and the relationship among the State, Market and Governance in Planning
- University-level teaching experience, preferably graduate, in classroom as well as online
- Experience in research and publications in the area of expertise in peer reviewed journals
- Availability to advise student and direct capstone projects
- Experience and commitment to proposal writing and getting external funding
- Fluent in Spanish

Responsibilities

- Teach core graduate Planning courses, as well as emphasis area and elective courses and electives at graduate level, during day, night and Saturdays, in the classroom as well as online
- Supervise professional practice, and offer the Planning Practicum course
- Student mentorship, based on the Program needs
- Participate of institutional committees as needed
- Obtain external funds
- Conduct research that produces at least four publications in his or her area of expertise, two of them peer-reviewed, during the first five years


