

## TENURE TRACK TEACHING POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Department of Chemistry, College of Natural Sciences at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico announces the search for candidates for two tenure track teaching positions, effective on January 2, 2023.

## Requirements:

- Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Chemistry or related disciplines, in the areas of Material Chemistry and/or Polymer Chemistry, from a recognized and accredited university
- Experience and research plan to develop Lithium and non-Li Batteries (or their components)
- Relevant postdoctoral experiences.
- Teaching experience at the university level.
- Proven capacity for research in their area of expertise.
- Committed to excellence in teaching and research.
- Proficiency in Spanish or English.

Responsibilities: Conduct research and publish in their areas of expertise in peer review journals; supervise thesis, dissertations and professional practices; develop proposals seeking external funding; teach undergraduate and graduate courses and seminars in daytime, night and Saturday hours, online and face-toface; actively participate in departmental and university service activities and projects. The responsibilities of the prospective candidate are covered by the General Bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.
