TENURE-TRACK TEACHING POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The School of Architecture, at the Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico, is interested in recruiting for a tenure track teaching position, effective on January 2, 2023.

Requirements:

1. Professional degree in architecture, Master's, or Doctoral degree granted by a recognized and accredited institution.
2. Minimum of three (3) years of teaching experience offering architectural design courses and courses specifically focused on **the technologies of construction processes and explorations with emergent materials applied to the profession**, preferably supported by digital tools and programs, at both undergraduate and/or graduate levels in a recognized and accredited architecture school.
3. Preferably with demonstrated experience in investigations in materials, technologies, and systems of construction processes.
4. Minimum of five (5) years of professional experience in architecture (design, construction documents development and/or construction management) and/or experience in the design, construction and/or investigation of materials, technologies and systems of the construction processes.
5. Preferably with an active professional license in architecture.
6. Capacity to direct and counsel master's thesis and research.
7. Capacity for in person and online teaching.
8. Experience in research, creative work, and architectural work.
9. Commitment to pursue external funding.
10. Publications in candidate's area of expertise.

Responsibilities:

The tasks that correspond to this teaching position include teaching architectural design courses and other specialized in-person and online courses, availability to offer weekend and evening courses, at undergraduate and graduate levels, with a demonstrated particular interest in emergent architectural production, research, and publications in the candidate's area of expertise, mentoring, participation in academic committees, and administrative support as part of the contractual obligations.

The recruited teacher will be responsible for offering architectural design courses and courses specifically focused on the technologies of construction processes and explorations with emergent materials applied to the profession, preferably supported by digital tools and programs, as well as forge collaborations and apply for interdisciplinary research funding with industries and institutions related to the discipline of architecture and construction.

2. Updated *Curriculum Vitae* of maximum (5) pages.
3. Official professional and academic credentials of all degrees.
4. Evidence of Master and/or Doctoral thesis supervision and/or counseling, as well as courses offered at university level indicating modality: in-person, online and/or hybrid.
5. Evidence of recent presentations at conferences, publications, and research work.
6. Portfolio of professional and creative work.
7. Teaching and research philosophy statements, maximum one (1) page each philosophy.



8. Statement of intention to pursue external funding.
9. Two recommendation letters.

*All submitted documents must have an English or Spanish translation.
