



TENURE-TRACK TEACHING POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Graduate Program in Translation, College of Humanities, Río Piedras Campus of the University of Puerto Rico, offers an MA in Translation. The Program announces a search for a tenure-track teaching position in English-to-Spanish and Spanish-to-English Translation, effective on January 2, 2023.

Requirements:

- Ph.D. in Translation or Translation Studies from an accredited university;
- Proven practical experience in translation both from Spanish-to-English and English-to-Spanish;
- Hybrid and online teaching experience at the university level;
- Commitment to excellence in teaching and research
- Versant in the use of TEnTs.
- Must be near-native speakers of Spanish and English with oral and written proficiency in both languages
- Knowledge of a third language is desirable.

Responsibilities:

Teach hybrid and online graduate courses and seminars following a flexible schedule that may include days, evenings, and Saturdays; publish translations or original research in curated digital or print formats; supervise master's capstone projects; participate actively in departmental activities (committees and other responsibilities), as well as activities at the College of Humanities and the Río Piedras Campus; develop proposals seeking external funding; and fulfill all other obligations of a teaching position. Full-Time Equivalency is 24 credits per academic year. The responsibilities of the prospective candidate are covered under the bylaws of the University of Puerto Rico.

Required documents:

1. Intent letter describing their teaching philosophy and experience, as well as relevant publications
2. Curriculum Vitae
3. Copy of the academic credentials of all their degrees
4. Evidence of their professional and creative work and achievements
5. At least one teaching evaluation
6. Three (3) recommendation letters


