Requirements

- Doctorate in Social Work awarded at or before the time of hiring
- <u>Master's Degree in Social Work from a CSWE accredited program</u> (if it is a degree from another country, it must be validated in Puerto Rico)
- Extensive practical experience in Social Work
- Minimum (3) years of experience as a teacher in academic institutions, preferably on related courses in at least one of these areas
- Theoretical-conceptual depth and knowledge of the philosophical foundations of social work

Recommended

- An active research project
- Willingness to teach method and practice in Social Work and research courses both at master's and doctorate levels.
- History of professional publications and presentations in your area of expertise in professional or academic forums
- Active participation in matters of Community interest
- Disposition to direct master level thesis and teach in the Master Program
- Capacity to direct doctoral dissertations and teach in the Doctoral Program
- Disposition to teach during daytime, nighttime, Saturday and distant modalities
- Willingness to develop research proposals
- Proficiency in Spanish and English

Required documents

- Letter of interest indicating area in which you want to teach and disposition for full, part time or both appointments.
- Updated, signed, and dated Curriculum Vitae (including email)
- Official transcripts and diplomas of all degrees
- Puerto Rico Social Work License and the Social Work Professionals College of Puerto Rico membership.
- Other documents that demonstrate the candidate's academics and professional expertise.
