CALL FOR TENURE-TRACK TEACHING ANNOUNCEMENT

The Humanities Department of the College of General Studies in the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus is a unit that organizes its academic work around inter, multi and transdisciplinary courses and services to the student body, announces a search to fill one tenure track faculty position in humanities to begin on August 1, 2023.

Requirements

1. Doctoral Degree (PhD) in the Humanities, specifically a medievalist with a mastery of the history, culture, visual arts, architecture and literature of the medieval period.
2. Three (3) years or more of experience in teaching courses in the humanities.
3. Minimum of three (3) presentations at local or international congresses concerning their research work in their area of specialty in the last five (5) years.
4. At least three (3) refereed articles published on their research work, either in their discipline of specialty or in projects related to teaching in peer-reviewed journals in the last five (5) years.
5. Ability or potential to offer courses in different departments where the diverse areas included by General Studies are emphasized.
6. Evidence of being current in the information and communication technology competencies and skills required in teaching college courses.
7. Experience in teaching university distance learning courses.
8. Commitment to the preparation of research proposals and projects.
9. Evidence the commitment and ability to seek external funding for research.
10. Knowledge of the mission, goals and objectives of the College of General Studies and the Department of Humanities.

Job Description

Teaching courses in the Department of Humanities. Be available to offer courses in other departments and programs of the College of General Studies, and in other colleges of the Rio Piedras Campus and the University of Puerto Rico. Create and teach new courses in the various educational modalities: in-person, distance, and hybrid. Develop academic research and disseminate it. Publish research in peer-reviewed academic journals. Provide institutional service, participate in committees, attend seminars and workshops for professional development. Participate in institutional evaluation and assessment processes, and comply with the requirements contained in the General Regulations of the UPR.
