

CALL FOR CANDIDATES FOR A ROSTER OF PROFESSORS

The English Department of the College of General Studies at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus seeks to develop a roster of professors for temporary teaching full-time or part-time contracts for the 2023-2024 academic year.

Requirements and Preparation:

Ph.D., Ed.D., or MA from an accredited university in TESOL, ESL/EFL, English Education, Bilingual Education, Composition/Writing, Literature, or related fields. Primary field of expertise should be in TESOL, ESL/EFL, or Bilingual Education. Additional experience in literature and/or composition is preferred. Through their application materials, candidates should demonstrate their:

- Teaching experience at the college level.
- Commitment to teaching first-year students in English language acquisition and English composition courses.
- Commitment to teaching excellence.
- Experience using technology to support student learning.
- Familiarity with theories related to the role of language learning in General Education.
- Availability to offer classes in other departments within the College of General Studies.
- Fluency in English and Spanish.
- Experience teaching diverse student populations.
- Experience online education.
- Training and/or experience teaching in different modalities (in-person, hybrid, and distance).
- Evidence of professional certifications.

Responsibilities:

Teaching duties include undergraduate classes held during the day, early evenings, and Saturdays through different modalities, which include in-person, hybrid, and distance.

Teaching duties will focus on ESL/EFL or English composition courses.

Professors in this department are expected to participate actively in department, college, and university committees and activities.

Professors in this department must comply with all the teaching responsibilities stated in the University of Puerto Rico bylaws.

- 2) Updated Curriculum Vitae
- 3) Copy of official academic credentials of all degrees
- 4) Copies of certificates


