Call for Tenure Track Position

The Department of Computer Science of the College of Natural Sciences at the University of Puerto Rico, Río Piedras Campus announces the search for candidates for one full-time tenure track faculty position in Computer Science with priority in the areas of Cyber Security, Operating Systems, and Artificial Intelligence, as well as related areas such as Software Engineering, Mobile Computing, Systems, Machine Learning, Data Science. **This is a full-time tenure-track position with an anticipated starting date of August 1, 2025.**

Requirements: Applicants must possess a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in Computer Science or very closely related discipline from an accredited university whose degrees are recognized by the University of Puerto Rico. They must have a strong research background demonstrated through peer-reviewed publications, conference presentations, and active academic engagement. Candidates should also have the capacity for excellence in undergraduate and graduate teaching, both in-person and online, and a commitment to securing external funding. Additionally, applicants must be proficient in English and/or Spanish for effective communication in academic settings.

Responsibilities: Faculty members are expected to conduct research, publish in peer-reviewed journals and conferences, and seek external funding through grant proposals. They must also supervise master's and doctoral dissertations in Computer Science. Additionally, they are responsible for teaching undergraduate and graduate courses through in-person and distance learning modalities during daytime, evening, and Saturday sessions. Faculty members are also expected to participate in committees, departmental initiatives, and university activities while fulfilling all faculty responsibilities outlined in the General Regulations of the UPR.

Required documents: (1) Curriculum vitae; (2) statement of purpose which describes your professional plans for research; (3) statement of purpose which describes your professional plans of teaching; (4) copy of the official credentials for all degrees (5) at least two recent letters of recommendation (three preferred); (6) evidence of publications and other relevant achievements.

The submitted documents should demonstrate strong research capabilities, effective teaching at the university level, in person and remotely, and, if applicable, professional experience and experience in preparing proposals or commitment to seeking external funds.
