1. **NO testing out of cycle.**
2. **You MUST TAKE the test @ THE DESIGNATED TESTING SITE. RIO PIEDRAS**
3. **You must have a valid ID to enter the testing session. No ID, NO Test**
4. **You bring your CDC Vaccination card or you Vacu ID**
5. **You must sign up for testing BEFORE appearing and attending at the testing site.**
 - a. **To sign up for testing request a slot to the Testing Control Officer at omayra.vedbraaten@upr.edu**
 - b. **In your testing slot request include full name including two last names, your cell number, your email address, MS Level, and ROTC Campus**
6. **No Walk-Ins or Drop-ins allowed on testing day. NO PREVIOUS SIGNUP, NO TEST**
7. **If you are a cadet and you are not attending English Language Courses you can't take the ECLT, in the case that you do your score will be revoked. YOU MUST ATTEND LANGUAGE COURSES**
8. **If you have issues with testing dates and times, you must inform your Cadre and Language Instructor, then you will write an email to the Testing Control Officer explaining the situation and send proof. The TCO will study your case and look for possible solutions.**
